

A Campus Divided: Confronting the Racist, Anti-Semitic, and Red-Baiting Politics of the University of Minnesota from 1930-1942

Riv-Ellen Prell, an anthropologist, is Professor Emerita of American Studies at the University of Minnesota, and past Director of the Center for Jewish Studies.

Wednesday, September 6, 2017, 7:30 p.m. at Temple Israel Cosponsored by the University of Minnesota, JCRC and Temple Israel.

An exhibition co-curated by Riv-Ellen Prell and Sarah Atwood-Hoffman opening at the University of Minnesota Andersen Library on August 14 explores both the inspiring and disturbing story of racism in campus life. Student activists worked hard for change as they encountered on-campus racism and challenges to their rights to protest and hold a range of political views. At the same time student housing was segregated, and off-campus boarding houses' refusal to accept Jewish and African American students was sanctioned by the University. The exhibition tells the story of many of these forgotten activists who went on to remarkable careers and continued commitment to change.


